

## **BMRC Trophy 2010**

1. The SMRC club's 'Champion of Champions' competition. This is run based on six qualifying meetings and scores the first six cars home in each SMRC main race for Scottish Championships. These being, **Fiesta XR2s (including STs), Mini Coopers, Saloons and Sports Cars, Legends Cars, Classic Sports and Saloons, and Formula Ford 1600.**

Invitation classes, guest or celebrity cars do not score points.

2. **The qualifying meetings are: Knockhill – April 18<sup>th</sup>, May 8 / 9, July 25<sup>th</sup>, August 21<sup>st</sup>, September 19<sup>th</sup>, October 17<sup>th</sup>.**
3. **In the case of a double or treble header only the first championship race scores points. Except for Scottish Legends, who have the BMRC points scoring race as the Final race of their normal three races per round. When Legends have a double header it is their first Final of that meeting that counts as the BMRC scoring round.**
4. Where drivers race in more than one class at a meeting, it will be the first race they take part in that will count as the points scorer. Only one race per meeting will count as scoring points in the BMRC Trophy. If any classes above are combined, then points will still be scored separately in these classes as the race will be deemed to be two races run in one.
5. **Scoring - Points will be awarded for the outright result in races on a sliding scale of 9, 6, 4, 3, 2 and 1 point for 1st to 6th place. An additional point will be awarded if a driver establishes a new lap record for their class (XR2/ST, Mini Cooper, Saloon/Sportscar classes A-D, Legends, Classics classes A-D ) in each scoring race.**

**All rounds count.**

6. In the event of a tie at the end of the final qualifying round, this will be resolved using the formula listed under Regulation J.3.4. in the 2010 M.S.A. Yearbook.
7. A trophy will be awarded at the annual SMRC prize giving ceremony to the winner. Other awards may be added by the SMRC committee.
